# **Contextual Summary**

This resource is for key stage 5 students who are studying Textile Design for AQA or textile-related subjects (as part of Applied Art & Design or Art & Design) with any of the following exam boards: edexcel, WJEC, OCR, CCEA.

The resource is a brief introduction to the opportunities for students at the Isle of Wight Steam Railway.

By prior arrangement, students are able to visit the upholstery workshop and view the partially-restored/fully-restored carriages to see how textile design is utilised for form and function, and how the textiles represent style, genre and traditions of a period in history in the heritage railway environment.

### **Task Implementation**

Tasks will be dependent on students' individual needs based on their course outline and intended outcomes or project objectives.


Students, teachers or educational establishments will need to contact the Isle of Wight Steam Railway to ensure a suitable visit plan is implemented.
