TEACHER NOTES

Chronological Understanding -Placing Railway Events in Chronological Order





Contextual Summary

This task enables students to practise their understanding of chronology, using dates and events that link specifically to the Isle of Wight Steam Railway. The task is relevant to students in key stages 1, 2 and 3.

Questions have been chosen because they link with core History skills as required at these key stages.

Task Implementation

The skills used in completing the task should be introduced before the visit to the Isle of Wight Steam Railway, in class, to ensure understanding of chronology and historical dates, etc. Students could practise ranking themselves in order of birthdays, for example.

An understanding of the general history of transport and its development would also be useful preparation for this task.

When on site, students will be able to undertake the task elements and can practise their chronological understanding.

The task is ideally completed on-site, to allow for the completion of all questions.

Ability Levels

There are 4 versions of this resource, one for key stage 1, two for key stage 2 (lower and upper years), and one for key stage 3. These have been designed as mixed ability resources and teachers can adapt them as suitable. For example, SEN or lower ability students could complete only page one.

KS2 students, or the KS1 resource for lower ability KS2 students. This gives as much flexibility as possible here.




Key skills practised in this unit:

- ► Interpreting information

- ► Recording information

Relationship to Curriculum

The above skills are required to be taught and practised as per the National Curriculum 2014 and Curriculum for Excellence, at key stages 1, 2 and 3 (and equivalents) in History.





Learning Opportunities

Pre-Visit

The skills needed for the task should be discussed in class prior to the trip so students are aware of the information they need to discover, how to place items in chronological order, etc.

During the Visit

Post Visit

Follow-up tasks could include:

- Whole class discussion about the responses to the questions
- Groups presenting back their collated ideas to the class
- ► Compounding learning by developing further skills, using more challenging questions

Enrichment Opportunities

Opportunities exist for the student to gain a more detailed knowledge of the history of Isle of Wight railways, and specific aspects of the Isle of Wight Steam Railway. It is anticipated that an enriched understanding of context will be gained.

Learning Outcomes

Students will be able to demonstrate their understanding of chronology by specifically demonstrating their abilities in practice, by finding, interpreting, synthesising and presenting the required information.
