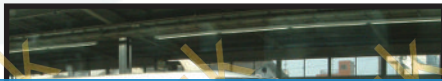

Placing Isle of Wight Railway Events in Chronological Order

Below is a list of events that happened on the Isle of Wight Railway from 1862 onwards.

- Can you put them in the right order?
- Number the events from 1 to 10, 1 being the earliest, and 10 the most recent.



Event	Date	Number
Last steam train runs on Ryde Pier	24th September 1966	
Ryde St John's Road to Shanklin line opens	23rd August 1864	
Letting of Ryde Pier Gates to Pier Head Tramway	29th August 1864	
Isle of Wight Steam Railway Havenstreet to Smallbrook Junction line opens	20th June 1991	
Old London Underground Trains first in use	13th July 1989	
Head-on Accident takes place at Sandown	15th April 1871	
Brading to Bembridge line closes	21st September 1953	
Ryde Pier Gates to Pier Head Tramway opens	29th August 1864	
Isle of Wight Steam Railway Havenstreet to Smallbrook Junction line opens	20th June 1991
