Ears

Tail

On a donkey, these are tougher, smaller, more elastic and more upright than they are on a horse.

Chestnuts

Longer and coarser than on a horse, but the texture can vary. Does not have as much natural grease as a horse's does and so the donkey is not protected from rain, snow and wind.

Hooves

Short and rarely longer than several inches. Coarse in texture.

Coat

Like that of a cow because it is covered in short body hair except for a tuft on the end!

Mane

These are long, and well-supplied with blood vessels. They are a desert adaptation for cooling the body.
