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This huge story is going to be reported on the news and your group has to show that you can give the most accurate TV News Report on the heist.


Are you up for the challenge?

Film all of the elements you will need!




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✓ You could write your script for the newsanchor here at Blackgang, or just note down some ideas to include in a full script back at school!
