Student Introduction

- ▶ Now you've explored every inch of Blackgang Chine, it's time to tap into your own imagination!
- ▶ This fun task will test your creativity - you will design and create a board game (with instructions) based on your visit to Blackgang Chine!

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- » You will work with a partner and follow a process to achieve this task.

FIRST STEPS

WITH A PARTNER, OR IN SMALL GROUPS:

Discuss

1. Make a list of all the activities you enjoyed at the park!
2. Decide which of these you will use in your board game.

Plan

3. Work out what style of board game you want to create.
4. Jot down some ideas of events and actions for the game.
5. Try to think of some unusual ideas to make your game different.

Note: Beware of making it too complex!

Draft

6. Draw a rough plan of your board layout.
7. Have a quick practice play to see if it works!

Edit & Name

1. Ask someone you trust for feedback, then make any changes to improve the game:
 - ✓ *Is there a clear direction from start to finish?*
 - ✓ *Are there enough action squares?*
 - ✓ *Are the actions too similar?*
 - ✓ *Are there any spelling mistakes?*
2. Come up with an effective name for your game.

Draft the Instructions

- » Start by explaining the object of the game. What do you have to do to win?
- » Give instructions from the beginning e.g. how to set up the game and how to start.
- » Don't forget to use commands and time adverbs.

Check & Edit

- ✓ Carefully read through your instructions aloud to your partner.
- ✓ Do they make sense?
- ✓ Make any necessary changes.

Write up Instructions

- » Write or type up the instructions.
- » The other partner can make finishing touches to the game board.

Play each others' games

- ✓ Read the instructions carefully first.
