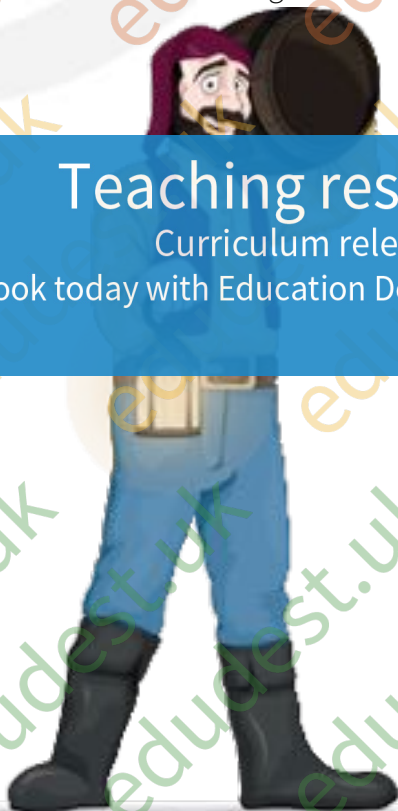


## Chine Experts Required!

## THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

1. On your information poster, how will you present your map and show people where the chines are?
2. Will you use arrows and photographs alongside your grid references?
3. Will you be able to use compass directions to tell people where they are?
4. Think about the connectives which you use to explain how chines are formed. Remember - you will watch a short video to help you with this.
5. Use bold headings too! Think carefully about using the space on the poster - try to keep it clear for your reader.
6. Key things to include:
  - ✓ where the chines are
  - ✓ what they look like
  - ✓ how they were created
