Grouping the Dinosaurs is a challenge!

#### Student Introduction

- Classifying dinosaurs can be a tricky business!
- What information can you find out during your visit to the dinosaurs of Restricted Area 5 that helps you to classify





**STEP** 

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2. **Ornithischians** ('bird-hipped')

The Saurischians are then divided into subgroups:

- Sauropods
- Theropods (the only meat eating group)
- Herrerasaurids.

The Ornithischians are divided into subgroups

- **Stegosaurs**
- **Ankylosaurs**
- **Ornithopods**
- Ceratopsians
- Pachycephalosaurs.

YOUR TASK

Your challenge will be to find out which subgroups the Area 5 Dinosaurs fit into.

- ✓ Firstly you need to note if they are herbivores or carnivores (this is important your life) could depend on this!)
- Next you will need to make notes on different characteristics of the dinosau
- This information should be gathered in a table.



Record your observations in a table. Design your own table content, deciding which characteristics you will record, i.e. diet, teeth, plates, spines, etc.

Back at school, use your information to research which groups and subgroups the Restricted Area 5 dinosaurs belong to. Enter the results into the table below.
