- Imagine that an extraordinary event has occurred on one of the Red Funnel vehicle ferries or Red Jets. Write a newspaper report, detailing the story.
- Write a story opener which begins with a violently stormy journey on a ship. Create that sense of drama so that your reader is desperate to want to read the rest of the story.
- » Read a range of sea-inspired poems and use your Red Funnel trip to write in the style of a poet, crafting your own poem.
- » Write the text for a media advertisement advertising a themed 'fun day' aboard one of Red Funnel's vessels. Describe the things that will happen on the ship including all the fun activities that will take place! Can you persuade the public to book tickets?
- » Find out about the Mary Celeste. Imagine that something similar happened on one sailing on the Red Funnel Ferry, and that you were the first person to find the ship in the middle of the Solent. Write a detailed eye-witness report on what you experienced/saw/found so that you can inform the appropriate authorities.
