RED FUNNEL TIMELINE

- 1820 George Ward and William Fitzhugh of Cowes establish the Isle of Wight Royal Mail Steam Packet Company.
- Southampton introduces its own ferry service to Cowes, known as the Isle of Wight Steam Packet Company.
- **1912 SS Titanic**, the pride of the White Star Line, departs Southampton Docks assisted by the Company's tugs, on her fateful maiden voyage across the North Atlantic.

- **1974** A new ship, **MV Netley Castle**, begins service as the first roll-on roll-off vehicle ferry.
