Contextual Summary

This is an art resource that engages students in key stage 3 with their visit to The Model Village Godshill.

The resource incorporates a photography and sketching task, and enables students to develop their creativity and ideas.

Furthermore, it allows them to investigate abstract art forms and use their sketches/photographs as a stimulus to produce a piece of art work.

Students will choose their favourite sketch/image/close up from their visit to Godshill and recreate it in the abstract form.

Students can choose their preferred media (e.g. paint/pencil/textiles etc) but must provide justifications for their choices.

They will then reflect on their finished pieces and provide feedback/constructive criticism to each other.
