Geography

Human & Physical Geography: Using basic geographical vocabulary to refer to features

Contextual Summary

This is a geography resource that engages students with their visit to The Model Village Godshill.

When on-site, students will practise recognising human and physical features and describing them in a real environment.

The task is designed for students studying geography in lower key stage 2 and key stage 1.

Task Implementation

This resource is designed to support school trips to the Isle of Wight. It is a first-hand observation of the typical features of a village and is a specific area of the Model Village Godshill.

Students will apply observations of the typical features of a village, identifying human or physical attributes and using geographical terminology to describe them.

The activity will re-inforce their understanding of geographical concepts and vocabulary in a real-life context.

Like all field work activities, this resource will allow the children to engage with an exciting and new environment in which they can apply and develop their knowledge of the world around them

Ability Levels

There are two variants of worksheet: one for mixed ability students in lower key stage 2 and one for mixed ability students in key stage 1. Teachers can utilise these however they wish.

Key skills practised in this unit:

- ✓ Recognising features on resource as features in landscape
- ✓ Observational skills; the ability to observe and interpret features of physical and human geography.

- using fieldwork & observational skills.
