Let's find out what dinosaurs ate!

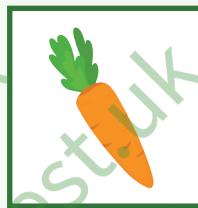
- ▶ The team at Dinosaur Expeditions have made a display of dinosaur teeth, fossils, models and pictures.

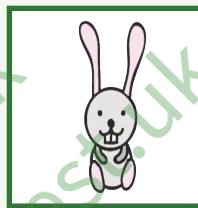

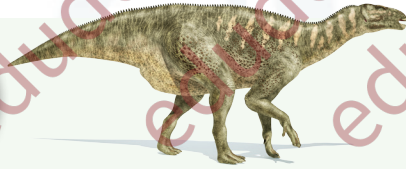

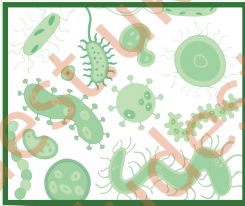
