- ▶ Give a reason for how they are feeling.

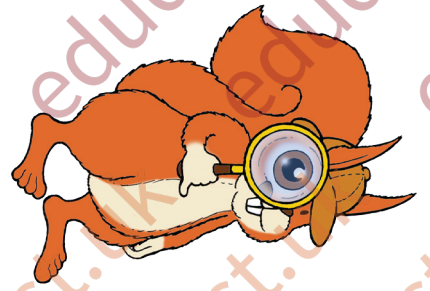
