- shape of ears

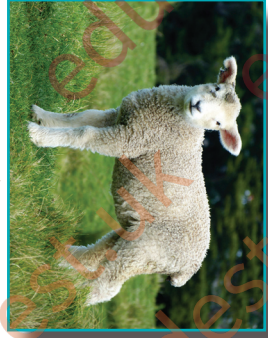


### STEP 1
